History of 200 South Third Street

- 1898 – Building opens as the social center of parishioners at Cathedral Parish
- 1899 – The building opens as Cathedral Grade School
- 1905 – The Brothers of Mary begin teaching there
- 1922-1923 – Cathedral is a four-year high school
- 1964 – Cathedral High School closes
- 1965 – Althoff Catholic High School opens as a co-ed high school, including students from Cathedral

After that, the building was leased to Belleville Area College, then became the Diocesan Office Complex. Most recently it has housed the marketing department and a workman's compensation rehabilitation department for St. Elizabeth's Hospital.
