Perinatal Educational Program

St. Elizabeth's Hospital Mother Child Center offers a wide range of services for mothers and infants, including birth in a modern labor and delivery suite and postpartum care with 24-hour rooming-in option available. The Special Care Nursery, directed by a neonatologist and staffed with specially trained nurses, is available for babies born with special healthcare needs.

To learn more about your pregnancy and the services available, you are cordially invited to participate in the Perinatal Educational Programs at St. Elizabeth's Hospital. A variety of classes are offered to meet individual needs. You are encouraged to register for as many classes as you desire. All classes are taught by the Mother Child staff.

Those who deliver at St. Elizabeth's Hospital will be given priority. As class size is limited, we recommend registering for classes early.

Prepared Childbirth Classes

Prepared Childbirth Classes teach relaxation techniques, controlled breathing, physical and emotional changes that occur during labor and birth. Pain control options including unmedicated, medicated and epidural will be discussed. Class discussions of inductions and cesareans are also included. Both mother and her support person learn how to take an active part in the birth process. The final class in each session will cover Infant Care and is available as an individual class for those not wishing to enroll in the full series - call 234-2120, ext. 2300 for available times.

A hospital tour of Labor and Delivery, Postpartum & Nursery is part of the schedule.

Choose between a six-week series of evening classes or the weekend series which takes place on two consecutive Saturdays. We recommend classes be taken around the 28th-30th week of pregnancy. **All inclusive fee per couple: \$25***
